American Educational Telecommunications (AET), LLC to Distribute Mobile Telehealth Solution

Omaha, NE, USA, May 4, 2009 – In the arena of Telemedicine, most medical consults occur via fixed video conferencing equipment in assigned rooms, or the equipment is attached to mobile carts and wheeled throughout the medical clinic, nursing home or hospital. However, in conjunction with its strategic partner Librestream Technologies, American Educational Telecommunications, LLC, (AET), offers the first totally mobile, handheld wireless video conferencing camera/system on the market today. The camera is called OnSight.

At less than three pounds, the OnSight camera and companion PC application, OnSight Expert, allows for two way audio communication between the physician and remote healthcare worker, along with one way video or instantaneous snapshots, by way of internet connectivity. Internet communication protocol is from any access point – wireless, cell tower or fast Ethernet cable. Further communication support between the physician and field personnel is accomplished through the use of “telestration” – the ability to perform live, on screen drawings that indicate areas of concern.

Priced far below other videoconferencing solutions, the OnSight technology will allow paramedics, EMTs, visiting nurses, dermatologists, and many other medical specialists in any conceivable area of the country to communicate live with a participating specialist. All video and snapshot information can be stored on either the OnSight Expert PC application, or on the OnSight camera, for addition to any patient related Electronic Medical Record (EMR).

Since 1999, AET has been engaged in telemedicine and in telehealth programming for consumer and professional use. The company has been active in both domestic US and International markets. The corporate offices are located at Scott Technology Center in Omaha, NE and in Norfolk, NE at its sister company, Midwest Health Partners. Both firms were founded, and are under the direction of CEO, Keith W. Vrbicky, MD.
